TO: THE PREMIER FOR CABINET SUB-COMMITTEE AND EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

RE: OVERSEAS TRAVEL TO SOUTH AMERICA

1. PROPOSAL

- 1.1 The Minister for Agriculture, Food and Fisheries, and Minister for Forests, the Hon Rory John McEwen MP, to travel to South America from Saturday, 07 July to Sunday, 22 July 2007 inclusive.
- 1.2 The Minister will be accompanied by Mr Roger Hartley, Executive Director, Industry Development and Ministerial Liaison. Mr Grant King, Chief Executive Officer, Limestone Coast Regional Development Board will also accompany the delegation at his own expense.
- 1.3 Recommend that Her Excellency the Governor in Executive Council appoint the Hon Patrick Frederick Conlon MP, Minister for Transport, Minister for Infrastructure and Minister for Energy to be also Acting Minister for Agriculture, Food and Fisheries and Acting Minister for Forests for the period 07 July to 22 July 2007 inclusive during the absence of the Hon Rory John McEwen MP.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Government has an economic development policy committed to supporting further development of trade and investment opportunities in key international markets.
- 2.2 The proposed mission will support this policy of enhancing economic growth in South Australia through an increased emphasis on trade development and assist to achieve the government's commitment to tripling exports by 2013.
- 2.3 A copy of the Acting Premier's approval (dated 17 May 2007) and a draft itinerary is attached.

3. DISCUSSION

- 3.1 The principal objectives of the visit are to promote trade in primary products and to observe developments in the wine, forestry and aquaculture industries. These developments represent opportunities and potential threats to our industries in South Australia. In particular the mission will seek to:
 - 3.1.1 Support and promote a number of SA Wine technology companies that will be attending the World Vinitech Trade Show in Santiago (12-14 July 2007);
 - 3.1.2 Promote exports of South Australian wine to Chile and Argentina;
 - 3.1.3 Advance discussions on aquaculture management in Chile and Argentina;
 - 3.1.4 Review developments in the plantation forestry industries;
 - 3.1.5 Investigate developments in primary industries research and development.

- 3.2 The Minister will be accompanied by Mr Roger Hartley, Executive Director, Industry Development and Ministerial Liaison. Mr Grant King, Chief Executive Officer, Limestone Coast Regional Development Board will also accompany the delegation at his own expense.
- 3.3 **Economic, financial and budgetary implications**
The visit is expected to bring positive benefits to the South Australian community flowing from increases in trade and investment from Chile and Argentina.
- 3.4 **Resources required for implementation**
Costs associated with this visit will be contributed by the existing budget of the Department of Primary Industries and Resources SA. These costs are estimated to be \$40,000, including airfares, accommodation and Austrade's facilitation costs.
- 3.5 **Staffing implications**
None.
- 3.6 **Regional impact**
As the trip may result in increased trade opportunities, it is likely to have a positive impact on regional South Australia.

4. RECOMMENDATIONS


It is recommended that Cabinet:

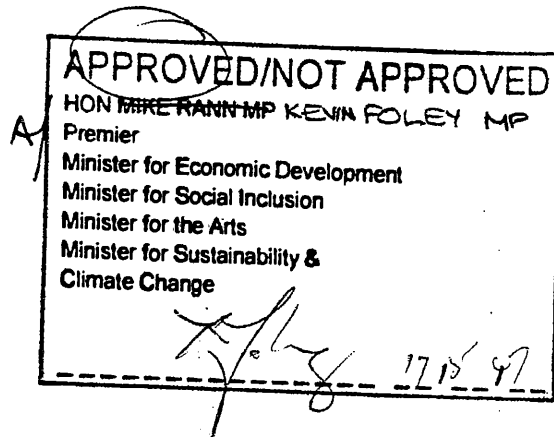
