One document was identified as answering the terms of your application and I have determined to refuse access to this document in full pursuant to clause 10(1). Under clause 10(1) of Schedule 1 to the Act, information is exempt from disclosure if it would be privileged from production on the ground of legal professional privilege. This document consists of legal advice provided to the government by its legal advisor, the Crown Solicitor, information which is subject to legal professional privilege.

Clause 10 – Legal Professional Privilege

- (1) *A document is an exempt document if it contains matter that would be privileged from production in legal proceedings on the ground of legal professional privilege.*

Right to internal review
