RETAIL TRADE, FEBRUARY 2017

Summary

During February, nominal retail turnover:

- rose 0.3% in South Australia in <u>trend</u> terms (nationally, nominal retail turnover rose 0.1%); and
- rose 0.1% in South Australia in seasonally adjusted terms (nationally, nominal retail turnover fell 0.1%).

Note: Retail turnover in current (nominal) prices incorporates changes in both prices and sales volumes.

Further Analysis

Trend

All states, except Queensland which fell by 0.1%, recorded an increase in February.

Compared with a year earlier, nominal retail turnover was 3.8% higher in South Australia and 2.9% higher nationally (see Table 1, Chart 1 and 2).

Through the year to February 2017, increases in South Australian retail turnover were recorded for Cafes, Restaurants and Take Away Food Services (up 8.4%), 'Other' Retailing (up 5.5%), Household Goods Retailing (up 4.1%), Food Retailing (up 3.8%), and Clothing, Footwear and Personal Accessory Retailing (up 0.3%). Department Stores recorded a fall in turnover in the month (down 4.5%) (see Chart 3 for contributions to growth).


Seasonally adjusted


During February, increases in nominal turnover were recorded in New South Wales (up 0.4%) and South Australia (up 0.1%). Western Australia (down 0.7%), Tasmania (down 0.5%), Victoria (down 0.3%) and Queensland (down 0.2%) recorded a fall in the month.


Compared with a year earlier, nominal retail turnover was 3.9% higher in South Australia and 2.7% higher nationally.
