### **Freedom of information application**

I refer to your request received by the Office of the Premier seeking access under section 13 of the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (the Act) to:

*From 17/03/2018 to 17/07/2018 - Since 17 March 2018, copies of any and all documents (including but not limited to physical, electronic, or written briefs, minutes, emails, diary entries and any other correspondence) regarding the Treasurer's review of government funding and/or Treasurer's review of government expenditure.*

The Department for the Premier and Cabinet (DPC) is responsible for providing determinations on behalf of the Office of the Premier.

Two documents were identified as answering the terms of your application and I have determined to release these documents as set out below:

- One document is released in full and a copy is enclosed;
- One document is refused in full.

### **Document refused in full**

Document 2 is a briefing note prepared specifically for use in Parliament, the disclosure of which would infringe the privilege of Parliament. I have therefore determined to exempt the document in full pursuant to clause 17(c) of Schedule 1 to the Act.

### ***Clause 17 – Documents subject to contempt etc***

*A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the public disclosure of which would, but for any immunity of the Crown—*

...

*(c) infringe the privilege of Parliament*

In compliance with Premier and Cabinet Circular PC045 - *Disclosure Logs for Non-Personal Information Released through Freedom of Information* (PC045), DPC is now required to publish a log of all non-personal information released under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991*.
