



# 2019 RUBY AWARDS

## Nomination Guideline: Made in Adelaide

This award recognises outstanding artistic or cultural achievement by a South Australian individual, company or organisation, for a particular work, event or project presented outside of South Australia.

This can include touring productions, events or visual arts exhibitions, special projects or initiatives that demonstrated a positive impact nationally and/or internationally and increased exposure for South Australia's arts and culture sector.

The award is open to:

- Arts and cultural sector
- Community organisations
- Individual artists
- Local and State Government
- Not-for-profit sector
- Private enterprise
- Professional artists and organisations.

## Award criteria

- Nominated works or events must have been presented outside of South Australia between 1 July 2018 and 30 June 2019.
- Nominees must be able to demonstrate positive impact outside of South Australia and increased exposure for the State's arts and cultural sector.
- Nominees must reside or be based in South Australia OR have been a resident or based in South Australia during a period of major professional achievement or development.
- Nominees must display artistic and creative merit, originality and overall excellence.

## Important information

Nominations can be made in more than one category, but separate nominations must be submitted.

By entering the Ruby Awards you are giving Arts South Australia the right to use your application material for awards-related promotional purposes including display and publicity.

All nominees are required to be available for a range of promotional activities including media interviews, photo and filming opportunities and attendance at the presentation event.

The Ruby Awards judges reserve the right to move a nomination into another category if deemed more appropriate.

The judges' decision is final and no further discussion will be entered into. Arts South Australia will not provide feedback to unsuccessful nominations.

Invitations will be issued to all finalists to attend the presentation event on **Friday 29 November 2019** at the Queen's Theatre.

## **Closing date**

The nomination must be completed and submitted with any support material no later than **5PM TUESDAY 8 OCTOBER 2019**.

Nominations received after the closing date will NOT be accepted.
