



2019 RUBY AWARDS

Nomination Guideline: Outstanding Contribution by an Organisation or Group Award

This award recognises a small-to-medium organisation or group that has made an outstanding contribution to Arts and Culture in South Australia.

The award is open to:

- Amateur companies
- Arts and cultural sector
- Community organisations
- Local and State Government
- Not-for-profit sector
- Private enterprise
- Volunteer organisations or groups.

Award criteria

- Nominees must be small-to-medium Arts or Cultural organisations or groups, defined as receiving no funding OR less than \$1 million in funding from Arts South Australia.
- Nominees must have demonstrated credibility through a body of work, creative originality, professionalism or leadership.
- Nominees must be based and operate in South Australia.

Important information

Previous applicants for the Outstanding Contribution by an Organisation or Group are encouraged to apply. Previous short-listed nominees and winners of the Outstanding Contribution by an Organisation or Group award can renominate in this category.

Nominations can be made in more than one category, but separate nominations must be submitted.

By entering the Ruby Awards you are giving Arts South Australia the right to use your application material for awards-related promotional purposes including display and publicity.

All nominees are required to be available for a range of promotional activities including media interviews, photo and filming opportunities and attendance at the presentation event.

The Ruby Awards judges reserve the right to move a nomination into another category if deemed more appropriate.

The judges' decision is final and no further discussion will be entered into. Arts South Australia will not provide feedback to unsuccessful nominations.

Invitations will be issued to all finalists to attend the presentation event on **Friday 29 November 2019** at the Queen's Theatre.

Closing date

The nomination must be completed and submitted with any support material no later than **5PM TUESDAY 8 OCTOBER 2019**.

Nominations received after the closing date will NOT be accepted.
