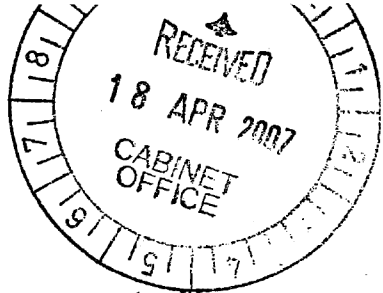
1. Proposal

- 1.1 That the Honourable Michael David Rann MP, Premier, Minister for Economic Development, Minister for Social Inclusion, Minister for the Arts and Minister for Sustainability and Climate Change travel to Cyprus, Italy, Greece and the United Kingdom for a period from 5 May 2007 until 23 May 2007 inclusive, to develop new and emerging opportunities particularly in the economic development, education, business and trade sectors.
- 1.2 That Her Excellency the Governor in Executive Council appoint the Honourable Kevin Owen Foley MP, Deputy Premier, Treasurer, Minister for Industry and Trade and Minister for Federal/State Relations to be also Acting Premier, Acting Minister for Economic Development, Acting Minister for Social Inclusion and Acting Minister for Sustainability and Climate Change for a period from 5 May 2007 until 22 May 2007 inclusive, during the absence of the Honourable Michael David Rann MP.
- 1.3 That Her Excellency the Governor in Executive Council appoint the Honourable John David Hill MP, Minister for Health, Minister for the Southern Suburbs and Minister Assisting the Premier in the Arts to be also Acting Minister for the Arts for a period from 5 May 2007 until 13 May 2007 inclusive, during the absence of the Honourable Michael David Rann MP.
- 1.4 That Her Excellency the Governor in Executive Council appoint the Honourable Gail Elizabeth Gago MLC, Minister for Environment and Conservation, Minister for Mental Health and Substance Abuse and Minister Assisting the Minister for Health to be also Acting Minister for the Arts for a period from 14 May 2007 until 22 May 2007 inclusive, during the absence of the Honourable Michael David Rann MP.

2. Background
