Guidelines

Outstanding individual achievement award

An outstanding individual who has distinguished themselves in promoting and celebrating multiculturalism, harmony and cultural diversity in South Australia for at least 10 years.

Arts and culture award

An individual or organisation making an outstanding contribution to promoting multiculturalism in the South Australian community through the arts or cultural activities.

Community sector award

An individual or team of employees or volunteers in a not-for-profit community organisation, including within a broader organisation, whose work has promoted multiculturalism and improved community harmony.

Media award

A journalist or media communicator who has demonstrated significant commitment or achievement in promoting multiculturalism and harmony, through traditional or new media, resulting in positive outcomes for the South Australian community.

Private sector award

A private sector business, team or employee providing outstanding services that foster cultural diversity in the workplace and/or in the community. This could include creating employment and training opportunities for and improving the economic status of people from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds.

Public sector award

A local, state or federal government department, unit, team or individual providing outstanding services that recognise, assist or promote cultural diversity in South Australia.

Volunteer award

An active volunteer with at least five years of service who has made an outstanding contribution to multiculturalism in the South Australian community.

Senior volunteer award

An individual over 60 years of age, who has been a longstanding volunteer within South Australia's multicultural community. The individual may be a volunteer in the not-for-profit, private or government sector.

Youth awards

An individual under 30 years of age, or a youth organisation or group of individuals under 30 years of age who have promoted multiculturalism and harmony in the South Australian community.

Nomination Details

Unless otherwise stated, judging is based on an assessment of outstanding contribution in the 12 months leading up to 11 October 2019.

Nominations should only be made in one category and the nominee must be nominated while they are living, however, the award can be awarded posthumously.

The nomination must include a supporting statement of up to 500 words that demonstrates the nominee's contributions and achievements in the selected category.

This statement should include:

- nominee's name and achievements (past and present)
- details of the nominee's contributions towards promoting multiculturalism and increasing understanding of cultural diversity in South Australia
- information about the positive impact of the nominee's efforts in the community
- the number of years the nominee has been engaged in relevant activities
- other relevant achievements or evidence of public recognition
- other relevant current or previous positions held by the nominee
- examples of publication/s, article/s, broadcast/s or other relevant media content to support the nomination (Media Award category only)
