Freedom of information application

I refer to your request received by the Office of the Premier seeking access under section 13 of the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (the Act) to:

All correspondence and all documents (including but not limited to physical, electronic or written briefs, reports, draft reports, minutes, memos, emails, letters, text messages, notes, diary entries and meeting notes) between the Premier/Premier's Office and the Minister/Minister's Office (Minister for Planning, Transport and Infrastructure) relating to Lang Walker, the Walker Corporation and/or any associated entities of Lang Walker, in the last six months. Date range – 01/08/2018 to 30/01/2019

The Department for the Premier and Cabinet (DPC) is responsible for providing determinations on behalf of the Office of the Premier. Under the Act, an agency has 30 days to respond to a freedom of information request. As DPC was unable to respond to your request within the time frame required, the department is deemed to have refused you access to all documents relevant to your application. However, I have determined to process the request as if the statutory time frame had been met.

Five documents were identified as answering the terms of your application and I have determined to release these documents as follows:

- I release two documents, in part, copies of which are enclosed; and
- I refuse, in full, the release of three documents.

Documents released in part

Document 1 and 5

Sections of these documents contain information relating to the personal affairs of third parties. Under clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 to the Act, information is exempt if releasing it would involve the 'unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person'. This information falls within the definition of personal affairs under the Act and I therefore determined it exempt from release pursuant to clause 6(1).

Additionally, sections of these documents not within scope of the application have been removed.

Document refused in full

Document 2 – 4

These documents are considered to be out of scope to your application and are refused release.

Clause 6 – Documents affecting personal affairs

- (1) *A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead).*

In compliance with Premier and Cabinet Circular PC045 - *Disclosure Logs for Non-Personal Information Released through Freedom of Information (PC045)*, DPC is now required to publish a log of all non-personal information released under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991*.


Right to internal review
