

3.4 Costs associated with the trip will be met from within existing budget allocations. Funds are available within the existing budget.



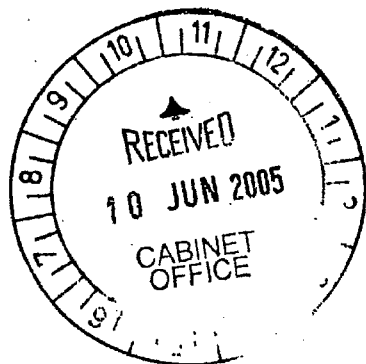
